TOP PRIORITY

- Medications
- Cell Phones

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

TIP: Be sure to place important documents in a sealed plastic bag so they do not get damaged.

- List of Illnesses/Allergies/Medications
- Mortgage Paperwork

FOOD & WATER

TIP: Be sure to have at least one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation.

- Garbage Bags
- Soap
